Dennis M. Hendrickson, Passed away on Friday, June 19, 2020, at the age of 69.

Dennis was born a “New Year’s Baby” on January 1, 1951. His life was filled with celebrations of family and friends. He was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting and fishing.

In 1991 Dennis met Dr. Jeffrey Coe at a Workers’ Compensation Lawyers’ Association lecture. The two formed a close bond that led to the founding of Occupational Medicine Associates of Chicago (OMAC), a specialty practice in work-related medicine. Dennis was the company director, leading OMAC’s marketing, customer relations, office administration, and even bill collection. Dennis’ focus and intensity helped make this medical practice successful for almost 30 years. Dennis was a driving force in the expansion of OMAC’s services, winning contracts for corporate physical examinations and helping to expand consulting services, ultimately including Fortune 500 companies both locally and internationally. But beyond this, Dennis was OMAC’s promoter, supporter, and the face of the practice at outings and events (fishing, hunting, golf) that he loved. And he even scored a hole in one!”

Dennis died peacefully with his beloved wife and family at his side.
