Richard Herman “Dick” Sievers passed away Tuesday, June 14, 2022 surrounded by his loving family.

Dick was born November 6, 1932 in Chicago, Illinois to Herman and Edna (Schuetz) Sievers and grew up on a farm in Peotone, Illinois.
